- · Kitchen exhaust fans have been designed for household use for regular cooking Using the unit for other purposes may cause risk of accident and should be considered as out of warranty.
- · Please observe rules and directives of competent authorities with regard to discharging outlet air (This warning shall not apply to uses without chimneys).
- The unit contains a power supply cord with earthed plug. This cord must be connected with an earthed plug.
- · In case of any danger, please ensure that plug is easily accessible to unplug in order to disconnect the power of product.
- · Foods that catch fire must not be cooked under the unit.
- · Please do not leave oil in heat on the oven. Containers with oil in heat may cause self- Ignition.
- · Please be sure to change the filters on time. Filters that are not changed on time pose risk of fire due to accumulated oil on filters.
- · Do not use non-heat resistant filtering materials in place of filter supplied.
- · In case any flaming starts, cut the power of exhaust fan and cooking devices. Cover the flame. Never use water.
- · Cut the power of unit be fore maintenance signs (To cut the power, unplug the unit).
- · For your personal safety, use "MAX 6 A" fuse for exhaust fan installation.


Unstitch folio papers on the unit for inox models after installation.

Selecting the Speed

The unit has 5 -step ventilation. Select one of ventilation steps from 1,2,3...to 5 according to cooking and frying steams. Pressing the command button on front panel will start the motor and will increase the speed while will decrease the speed. Electronically controlled models are equipped with TIMER. If you press button for longer than 2 seconds, timer function for 15 minutes will be activated. When timer starts, display will show a signal and motor will automatically stop after 15 minutes.

Please run the ov en and the unit simultaneously to create air current so that inhaling power will be positively effected. After cooking operation, keep the unit running for a while so that remaining odor and steam will be absorbed.


Lighting (Figure 4)

The unit has 2 pieces of lamps and a lamp button to control lighting. To start lighting, Push button.


MAINTENANCE

Unplug the unit or switch off before maintenance and cleaning. Aluminum cassette filter holds the dusts in the air and oil and it should be washed with hot soapy water or if dishwasher (at 60°C). Remove aluminum cassette filter by pressing on spring clamps at the end side. After cleaning replace it without drying. Exterior surfaces of exhaust fan should be wiped through a cloth we twith soapy water or alcohol. For inox products, using inox cleaner and maintenance products sold domestically will deliver a longer life.


Cleaning Periods for Metal Filters:

Metal filters should be cleaned once in 2 -3 weeks whenever "C" signal is ind icated on display or basing on the frequency of use. After cleaning and reassembling the filters, Push button for longer than 3 seconds to erase "C" signal. Display will show the letter "E" and normal operation will begin.

If you want to keep on opera ting without erasing "C" signal, active period will be shown for 1 second when you press buttons and then again "C" signal will be shown and motor will keep on running.


Replacing the Lamps


- · Cut the power connection of exhaust fan.
- · Remove aluminum cassette filter.
- · Dismantle defective bulb and replace with a new bulb of same value.
- To replace halogen bulbs, push downwards on back of lamp socket and remove the lamp to the bottom side and turn slightly clockwise and remove downwards. Turn counter-clockwise while assembling.




Replacing Carbon Filter (Figure 5-6)

- · Cut the power of exhaust fan before replacing the carbon filter.
- Carbon filter is used for kitchens without chimney outlets and therefore, it should be replaced once in every 3 -5 months basing on t he frequency of use. 2 pieces of carbon filters should be used for the product. Never wash the carbon filter.
- · To remove the carbon filter, turn counter-clockwise.





INSTALLING THE PADDLE BOX ON CEILING

- 1- Bore holes of 8 mm on the marked points and place inserts of 8 mm in to these holes. Fix ceiling installation sheet (A) with 4 pieces of screws (5,5 x 38) to the ceiling (Insert, screw and ceiling installation sheet are supplied with the unit).
- 2- Screw air outlet chimney (F) to the motor block (D) on both sides (Figure 2).
- 3- Screw 4 pieces of installation brackets (G) to the motor block (H). (Hanger bar twisting sides should be as shown in Figure 3). Paddle box is easily adjusted to any height thanks to installation brackets.
- 4- Pass external chimney (J) over internal chimney (I) (Abb.4).
- 5- Pass chimneys (I,J) over motor block (Abb. 4.1).
- 6- Attach ceiling installation sheet (A) (Figure 1) to G1 (Figure 5.1.A) and G2 (Figure 5.1.B) and screw to motor block on corners as shown in Figure 6.
- 7- For Sinus Isola: Screw the glass supplied with the unit to the panel (Figure 7).
- 8- For Multi Isola: Insert glass (M) into glass sheet (T) (Figure 12) in the lower section of panel and fix the glass by tightening the screws with plastic caps (P) (Abb12) placed in the inner section.
- 9- Affix hanger hook (L1) (Figure 8) into the L (Figure 8) hole on motor block.
- 10-Screw the panel to motor block (Figure 9.1).
- 11-Remove halogen lamps (Figure 16). Loosen 4 screws in the lighting sheet and remove lighting sheet (Abb.17).
- 12-Loosen the screws to remove split pin box (U) (Figure 18) cover and insert connectors to make 220V power cord and motor cord connections as shown in Abb.19.1 to electronic circuit inside.
- 13-Close split pin cover (Figure 20).
- 14-Replace lighting sheet and tighten the screws (Figure 21).
- 15- Assembly halogen lamps (Figure 22).
- 16-Connect filters (Figure 23).
